

Montgomery County Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Services

ADAMHS provides financial assistance to individuals seeking mental health and/or alcohol/drug addiction services with contracted agencies based on family size and income. No one is denied services due to lack of insurance. Your treatment provider will work to determine the services to support your ongoing recovery. Some non-Medicaid service benefits are available to identified high risk populations only, while some services are limited in the number of visits during the plan period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. Eligibility for the services is based on your Individual Service Plan that is created by you and your treatment provider.

Below are some of the services that may be available:

Mental Health Services may include:

- Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment
- Individual & Group Counseling
- Pharmacologic Management
- Assessment
- Vocational

Mental Health Plan Period Limits:

- 104 hours of community psychiatric supportive treatment
- 24 hours of pharmacologic management
- 52 hours of counseling
- 2 hours of assessment by physician
- 4 hours of assessment (non-physician)
- 90 days of mental health residential treatment at MorningStar/NOVA Behavioral Health
- 20 days of transitional housing at The Lodge

Alcohol & Drug Services may include:

- Case Management
- Individual & Group Counseling
- Medication Assisted Treatment
- Medical/Somatic
- Urinalysis
- Prevention
- Intervention

Alcohol/Drug Plan Period Limits:

- 90 days of alcohol or drug treatment Residential and/or room & board in an alcohol and/or drug treatment agency
